## Motherhood: A Calling From God

Introduction - History's most **FAMOUS** mother was called by God to a task just like parents and children are today.

- I. A mother called by God SUBMITS to His plan Luke 1:26-38
  - She didn't waiver from God's call
  - Was she afraid, nervous, unsure of her own abilities, anxious about prophecies concerning pain?... Absolutely
  - Like today, she wanted only the best for her child
  - What makes Mary worth imitating is that she had no room for commitment to anything else
- II. A mother called by God does not have to be **PERFECT**!
  - Example: Ben Carson's mother
  - Clear indication of Mary's imperfection John 2:1-4;
    - Matthew 12:46-50
  - In spite of her flaws, Mary raised the Messiah (God can use you too)
- III. A mother called by God never **<u>RELINQUISHES</u>** the title
  - Simeon's prophecy came true Luke 2:34-35
  - Mary was His mother from beginning to end John 19:25
  - All mothers (parents) know there will be pain, sleepless nights, harsh words, tough love, unacceptable actions, betrayal and rebellion; through it all, they never relinquish the title
- IV. A mother called by God sees God's **PLAN** for her children

- Mary suffered through the crucifixion, celebrated the resurrection and witnessed the Holy Spirit's arrival Acts 1:14
- Seeing God's plan for your children come to fruition is a blessing of a mother's commitment

Conclusion - Our prayer is that mothers would realize the importance of their role, would be immersed in God's Word and would be fully **COMMITTED** to the calling He has given them!
