Introduction - Passion week begins with the Triumphal Entry of Jesus Christ into Jerusalem.

I. The Foretelling - Luke 19:28-38

- The excitement of the crowds toward Jesus' entry
- Hosanna, **GOD SAVE US!** - From the oppressive tyranny of Rome - Zechariah 9:9
- Things Jesus **BORROWED**: manger, boat, fishes and loaves, upper room, **TOMB** and a donkey to carry Him
- Question: Can Jesus use us to carry His message to people in this city this week?

II. The Need

- Passover Week: Jerusalem swells to a million
- The Donkey: Made Him more **VISIBLE**
- Prayer: Prepares the way for others
- Invite: Using our hands to be relational
- Celebrate: What God has done for us

III. The Worth

- Tied to the post - overlooked?
- The Master **NEEDS** me?
- The donkey was used for the purpose he was created. A beast of burden carrying Jesus who carried the **BURDEN** of the World.

Conclusion - Let God use you because you just never know how He is orchestrating His Will and who will be affected by your actions.
