*Statement: You may have a relationship with God, but is it a **COVENANT** one?

- I. Five practices of covenant relationship
 - 1. **BLOODSHED** Colossians 2:11 NLT

Example: Jewish wedding practice/ **CUTTING** an animal

2. NAME CHANGE - John 14:13-14; Access pass

Example: Jacob to ISRAEL/ Identity

3. An **OUTWARD SIGN** - Genesis 9:16-17

Example: Inward reality revealed/ BAPTISM

4. A **MEAL** - Luke 22:19-20

Example: Marriage supper of the **LAMB**

5. An **EXCHANGE** of everything - Matthew 10:39

Example: **BETTER END** of relationship

- II. Two covenants Hebrews 8:7-9
 - 1. The old covenant is **EXTERNAL**; the new covenant is **INTERNAL**
 - Hebrews 8:10a NLT
 - 2. The old covenant has a **MASTER**; the new covenant has a **FATHER**
 - Hebrews 8:10b NLT
 - 3. The old covenant has GUILT; the new covenant has CLEANSING
 - Hebrews 8:12 NLT, Matthew 7:21-23
